



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

About the candidate requirements

Q: Why is there a limit on the nationalities for this programme?

This programme is sponsored by UNICEF's Regional Office for East Asia & Pacific, hence there is a focus on supporting young changemakers from the Asia Pacific region relating to our work.

Q: Does my solution need to use technology?

Not necessarily, but we are also looking for technology based solution and you may use it if needed.

About the benefits

Q: I need a visa to travel to Singapore, will this be covered?

UNICEF can provide a letter to support visa applications and can cover the visa application fees. However, we cannot guarantee the visa will be granted; this decision is taken by the Singapore Embassy in the country where you are applying.

Q: What are the mentoring sessions about?

Each Changemaker will be asked to have 2 sessions with a mentor to help them shape their idea into a concrete presentation and pitch. The sessions will be conducted online and in English and will each be about 1-1.5 hours in length. The mentor will also provide feedback and guidance on the next steps and support opportunities to connect with other industry leaders.

Q: Will UNICEF fund my idea?

The purpose of this event is to support young people to attend the Young Water Leaders Summit, and to give them a platform to present their idea for feedback from UNICEF and other experts. There is no guarantee of additional funding from UNICEF at this time.

About the application process

Q: When will I hear if my application is successful?

We aim to contact all successful candidates by end of April 2020.
